

APPLICATION CHECKLIST

Admission requirements, deadlines, and required application materials vary by program. Begin by reviewing the requirements and procedures for the particular academic program to which you're interested in applying. You'll find these requirements on the "Admissions" or "Admissions Requirements" pages linked from the program's academic home page on our College website - www.edgewood.edu. - Official transcripts of all academic coursework and degrees earned. Contact the schools you've attended and request they send hard copies of your transcripts Edgewood College. Most often this request is made to their Registrar's office. Instruct them to send the transcripts to:

- A written statement of no more than 500 words explaining what you hope to gain in your participation in the program, what experience you bring to the program, and how your experience and background will contribute to your success as a student at Edgewood College.
- Two letters of recommendation from supervisors, college or university professors, and/or colleagues who can comment on your qualifications for success in graduate school.

Written statements and letters of recommendation can either be mailed to the address above or emailed to: gps@edgewood.com. Some programs may have additional requirements for admission, such as a personal interview, resume, test scores, or other requirements specific to the program. Please review the admission requirements for the program you're interested in, or contact an admissions counselor.
